The proposed Project will provide better low water access to Lake Oroville for boaters and emergency responders. The proposed extension of the Enterprise Boat Ramp will occur west and south of the lowest elevation of the existing Enterprise Boat Ramp and involves site preparation, construction, and restoration.
