The proposed project will occur at Camarillo Airport, and is located on the southern portion of the airport, south of the Electrical Vault Building (34° 12'36.39" N and 119° 05'20.50" W). See attachment.

Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The proposed project will replace the beacon at Camarillo Airport. Currently, the existing beacon has surpassed its usable life expectancy, and sits atop a water tower outside of the airport and requires special certification for routine maintenance. The proposed project will allow for the airport to relocate the beacon onto airport property to allow for easier maintenance and upkeep to be undertaken by the airport maintenance staff.

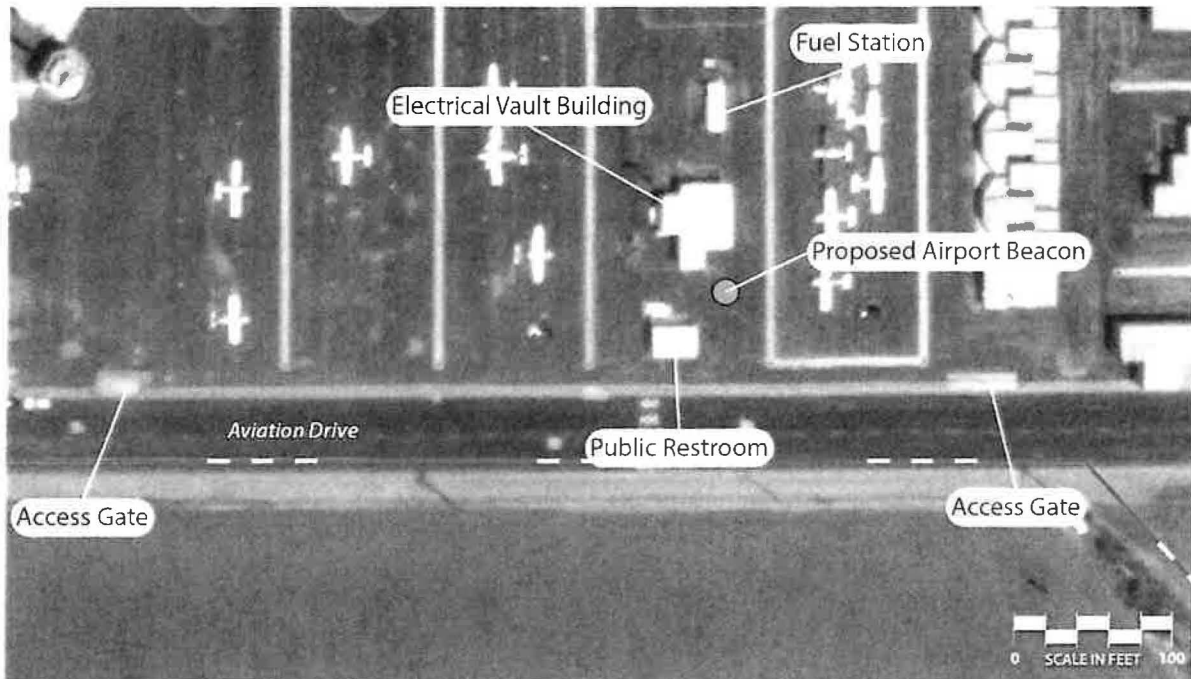

CEQA GUIDELINES 15300.2 - EXCEPTIONS

- (a) **Location.** The proposed beacon will be replaced at the following coordinates on the airport: 34° 12'36.39" N and 119° 05'20.50" W. The project area is located north of Aviation Drive, south of the airport's electrical vault building and north of a public restroom building.



- (b) **Cumulative Impact.** The proposed project will not contribute significant impacts over time with future beacon replacement projects, as it is not anticipated that a new beacon structure would need to be constructed, as the beacon would now be located on airport property.
- (c) **Significant Effect.** The proposed project involves the assembly and installation of a prefabricated tilt down tower structure and new beacon at the airport. The project area is currently paved and is not located near any environmentally sensitive resources.
- (d) **Scenic Highways.** The County of Ventura does not contain any scenic highways. However, the City of Camarillo has classified a few scenic corridors near the airport such as U.S. Route 101 (near the northern boundary of the airport) and Los Posas Road (along the eastern boundary of the airport). The proposed project will not be located near either scenic corridor nor will it significantly alter the visual environment of the airport environs.
- (e) **Hazardous Waste Sites.** According to the California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) EnviroStor website, there is one Formerly Used Defense Sites (FUDS) associated with previous military use of the airport (Oxnard Flight Strip). However, this site is listed as inactive and is not on the National Priorities List (NPL).

(f) **Historical Resources.** A cultural resources survey was completed at the airport in 2022 and did not identify any prehistoric or historic resources at the airport. Furthermore, the project area is on existing airport property and is not known to be of interest to Native American Tribes. The project's area of disturbance is also completely paved.
