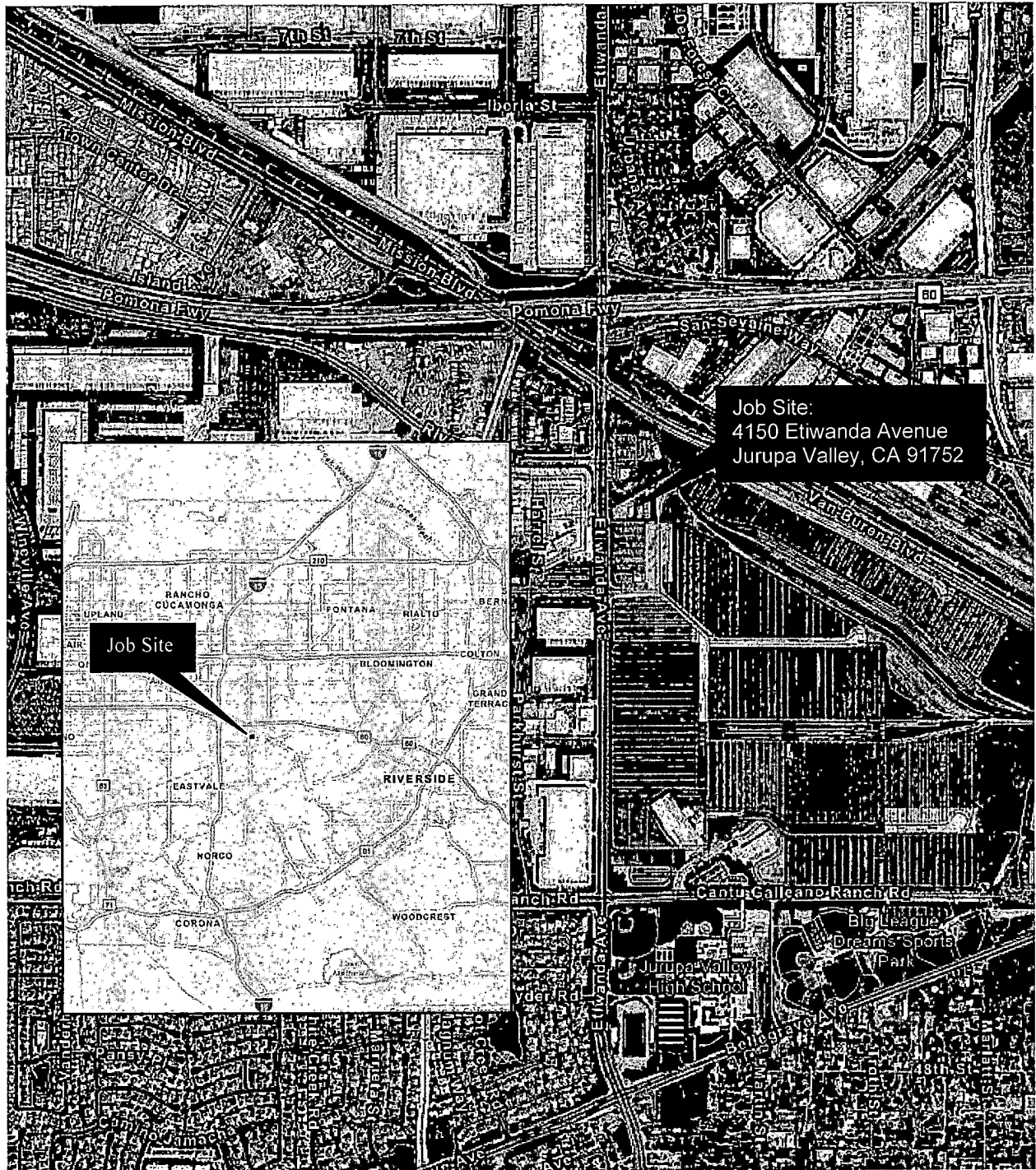


Figure 1 – Project Location

9. Description of nature, purpose, and beneficiaries of Project:	<p>The District's Roger Teagarden Ion Exchange Plant (RTIXP) has a total of ten (10) nitrate removal vessels. Currently the RTIXP operates seasonally from approximately July through November annually.</p> <p>The project consists of the spot repair of exterior paint of ten (10) nitrate removal vessels by using epoxy and acrylic/urethane protective coating system and the repair of all rusting areas of existing/interior linings and patch repair with an NSF ANSI Standard 61 certified immersion grade liner and paint interior areas with a thick film 100-percent solids epoxy of six (6) nitrate removal vessels at Roger Teagarden Ion Exchange Plant. Also responsible for air pollution control, fire protection, overspray and dust control, and shall comply with local sound and noise level rules and ordinances.</p> <p>This project will not have any excavation. However, Contractor is required to restore all areas altered by construction to pre-existing conditions. Such areas shall include, but shall not be limited to, areas used for travel, parking, and storage of vehicles, equipment and materials.</p> <p>Beneficiaries of the project are Jurupa Community Service District customers, which include residential and commercial users.</p>

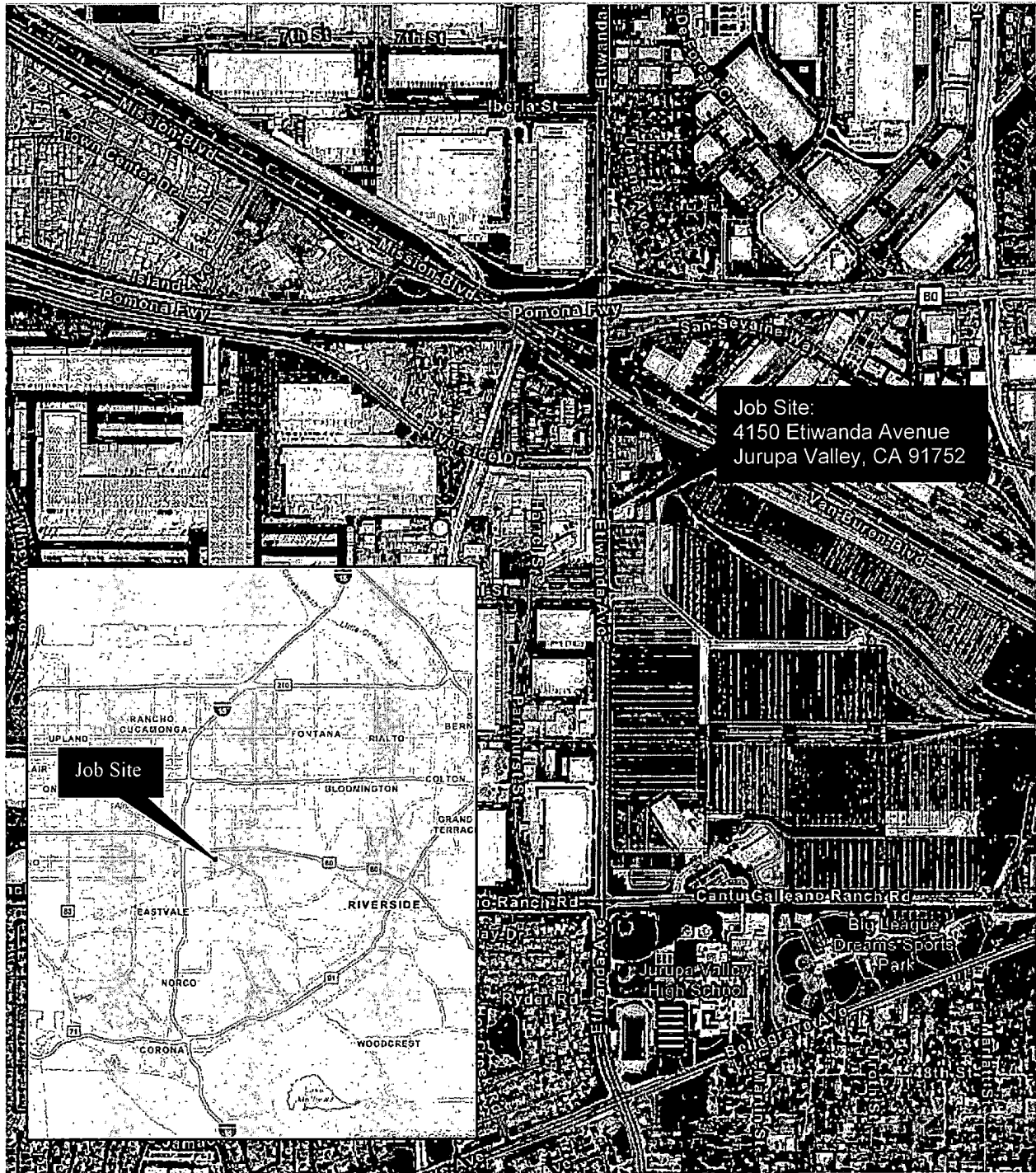


Figure 1 – Project Location
