The City of Redding (City) proposes to construct the Victor and Cypress Avenues Active Transportation Project (project). The purpose of the project is to safety accommodate active transportation, including people that walk, bike and roll. The project is needed because the roadway and trail segments included in the project area have discontinuous pedestrian and bicycle facilities, and for some sections, no facilities. Pedestrians and bicyclists are required to share roadways with motor vehicles, take circuitous detours or use unimproved (dirt surface) paths. Under existing conditions, some disabled pedestrians do not have a choice and must find alternative modes of transportation or share the vehicular traveled way.
