PROJECT LOCATION – COUNTY: The project is in Calwa bounded West by Orange Ave and East by Cedar Ave and Ninth St. at Burns Ave. The project is bounded South by the Jensen Bypass and North by Church Ave and Burns Ave at Ninth.

DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT: The County of Fresno Department of Public Works and Planning (County) proposes to make sidewalk and road improvements in the community of Calwa in Fresno County. The purpose of the proposed Project is to reconstruct Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant walkways, including sidewalks, curbs and gutters, and curb ramps; and to overlay various roads to provide for a continuous accessible path of travel and improve transportation within the community. Many of the existing ADA curb ramps are inadequate, forcing wheelchair users to travel on roadways alongside traffic. Additionally, roads within the community are in disrepair and need improvements. Large areas of the roadway within the community have paving that is worn, cracked, and uneven.

The scope of work includes:

- Replacing existing damaged or ADA non-compliant sidewalks and curb ramps with new ADA-compliant sidewalks and curb ramps.
- Install new curb ramps and sidewalks in areas where they are currently lacking.
- Replace several driveways as needed.
- Reconstruct or overlay the roadway, depending on the existing conditions.
- Adjusting Water valves, sewer manholes, and other roadway utilities as necessary

The project will construct approximately 18,000 linear feet of concrete sidewalk, 21 curb ramps and returns, 12,600 square feet of concrete approaches, and 6,000 linear feet of concrete curb and gutters. Sidewalks will generally be 5 feet wide. In some street intersections, pavement will need to be ground and re-graded to meet ADA maximum running or cross slopes compliance or standard. Maximum excavation depth will be 3 feet. Road overlay or reconstruction work is proposed within the bounding streets of Orange Ave to 9th St and Cedar Ave, and to Church Ave and the Jensen Bypass. Some trees and vegetation, as well as existing private encroachments will be removed to allow for the installation or replacement of sidewalks, curb, and gutters. The project will not change the alignment or increase the number of through-lanes, therefore, no permanent noise impacts will occur. The project will not increase the capacity of the road. No relocation of buildings, homes, or businesses will be required.

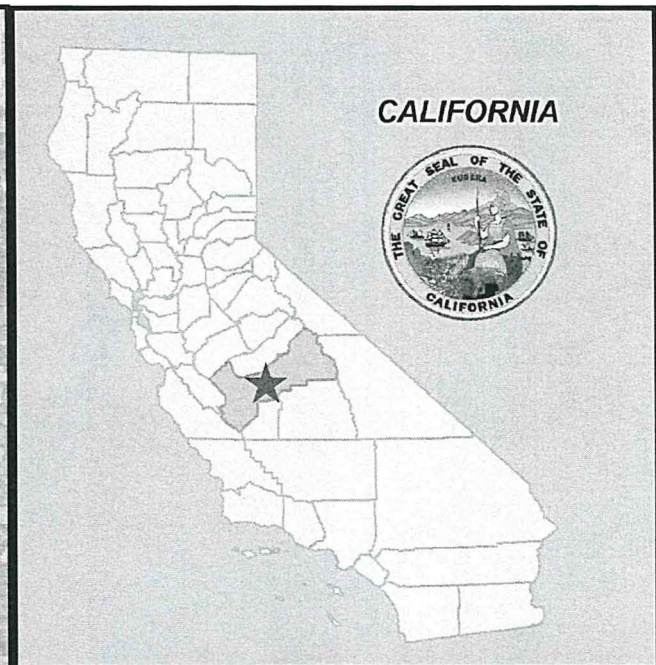
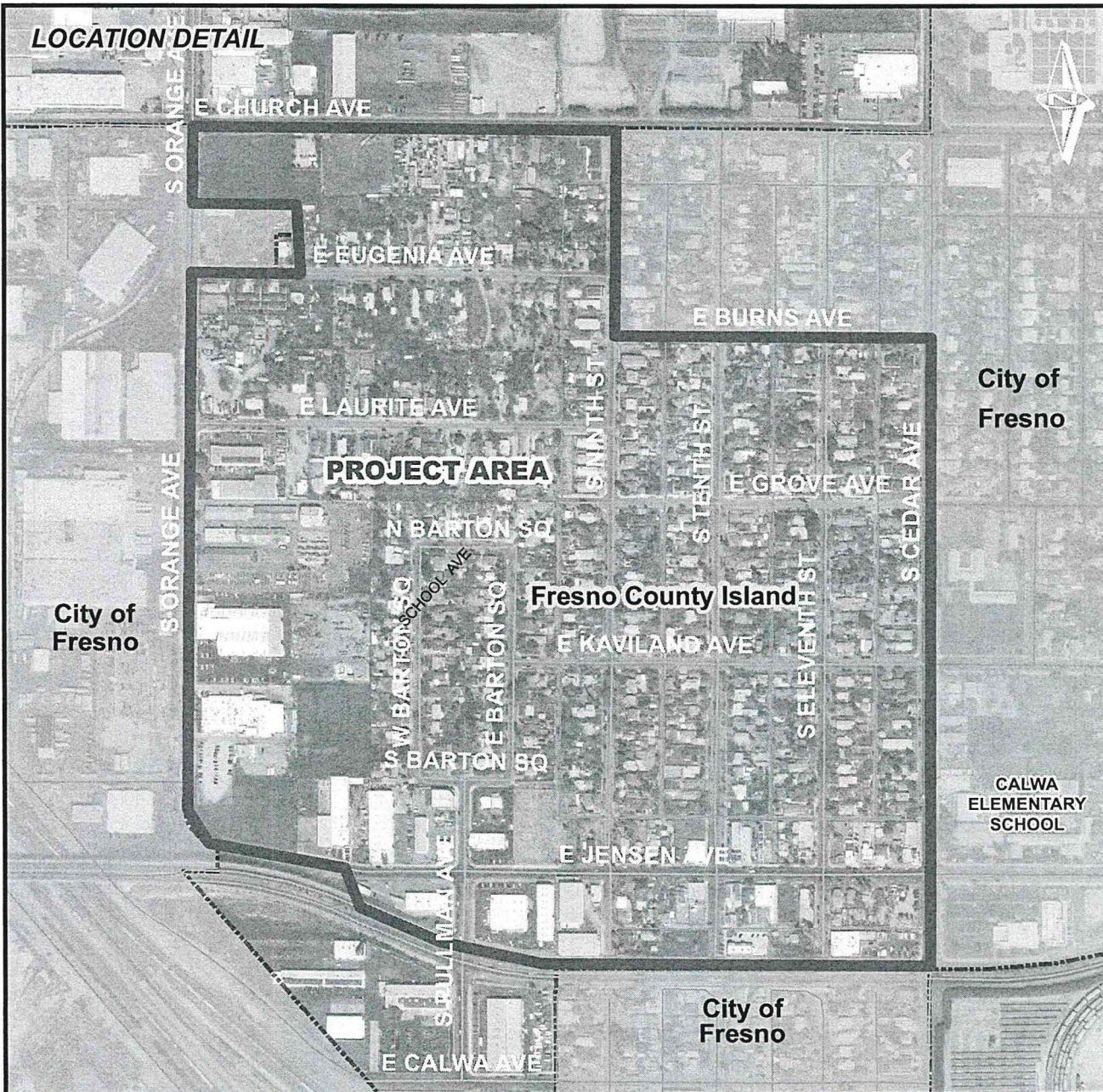

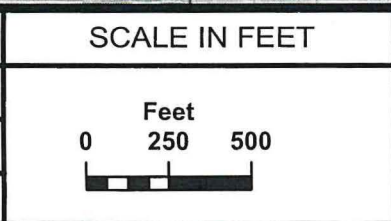
