Project Justification:

As part of an overall pavement maintenance strategy, these roadways are programmed for slurry seal on a seven-year cycle.

The roads within these project areas are mostly 12 to 45 feet wide two-lane urban local roads. These roads have not been resurfaced within the last 3 years. Roads with "Fair" or less Overall Condition Index (OCI) ratings will be reassessed again prior to the next cycle (2032) to determine if rehabilitation or other treatments are necessary.

Scope of Work:

The project will consist of:

- 1. Placing Slurry Seal (Type II) on the existing pavement.
- 2. Performing pavement repair to areas with structural failure to a depth of 0.50 feet with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA).
- 3. Removing any existing thermoplastic traffic stripes and pavement markings.


Environmental Setting:

Land uses along these roadways vary from suburban residential to rural-agricultural residential uses, commercial/institutional uses, industrial uses and agricultural uses.


There are mature trees along many of these roadways. Nesting and migratory birds, protected by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, may nest within these trees. Furthermore, the Swainson's Hawk, a raptor species of concern within the State of California and listed as threatened may nest adjacent to or within the project area. A pre-construction survey for nesting Swainson's Hawks and other migratory birds is recommended if construction is scheduled to occur from February 15th to September 1st.

Beneficiaries:

Residents and the driving public will benefit from the improved driving surfaces and reduced road noise.












Vicinity Map SLURRY SEAL LOCAL ROADS 2025 RD 1

EL RICADO AND RIVIERA CLIFFS










Vicinity Map SLURRY SEAL LOCAL ROADS 2025 RD 2

LINCOLN VILLAGE CENTRAL
















Vicinity Map SLURRY SEAL LOCAL ROADS 2025 RD2

OAKRIDGE AND PARKVIEW











Vicinity Map SLURRY SEAL LOCAL ROADS 2025 RD4
