Notice of Intent to Adopt a Negative Declaration and Notice of Proposed Section 4(f) *De Minimis* determination for the MEN 128 Culvert Rehabilitation and Fish Passage project.

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is proposing a project in Mendocino County on State Route 128 from post miles 0.0 to 50.5. The project proposes to rehabilitate 102 existing culverts and replace one culvert with a 34-foot long by 36-foot-wide bridge to remediate a fish passage barrier at Mustard Gulch (post mile 7.27).

WHAT IS AVAILABLE

The environmental document, referred to as an Initial Study (Negative Declaration), and a proposed Section 4(f) *De Minimis* determination (Appendix D of the Initial Study) for this project will be available for review until December 20, 2024 at the following locations:
