PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Campbell Tech Park Project (proposed project) site is a 17.28 acre site located in Campbell and is bounded by State Route 17 to the north and west, Campbell Technology Parkway and commercial uses to the south, and single-family development to the east. The proposed project includes the development of a 290 units residential development that consists of 27 two-story single-family detached homes, three-story townhome-style condominiums with 149 units across 28 buildings, and four-story townhome-style condominiums with 114 units across 15-buildings. The proposed project would demolish four existing structures totaling approximately 280,864 square-feet, to redevelop the site with the residential development and would include utility and infrastructure improvements, landscaping, construction of a new stormwater drainage system, and offsite improvements. PROBABLE ENVIRONMENTAL EFFECTS OF THE PROJECT

The Draft EIR evaluates potentially significant environmental impacts associated with the proposed project, consistent with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). The Draft EIR identifies the following categories as potentially significant: Air Quality, Cultural Resources, Tribal Cultural Resources, Land Use, and Transportation. No significant unavoidable impacts were identified for the proposed project.

CEQA requires this notice to disclose whether any listed hazardous materials sites are present at the location. As discussed in Section 7.0, Effects Found Not to be Significant, of the Draft EIR, the project site and surrounding sites are not included on a list of hazardous materials sites compiled pursuant to Government Code Section 65962.5.
