RESOLUTION NO. 1421

MAKING CERTAIN DETERMINATIONS RELATED TO THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) AND AUTHORIZING STAFF TO FILE A NOTICE OF EXEMPTION FOR THE SOLAR PANEL INSTALLATION PROJECT AT THE TRANSPORTATION CENTER AND THE WINONA CENTER

WHEREAS, the Twin Rivers Unified School District (District) is committed to maintaining and improving school facilities to ensure safe, functional, and sustainable learning environments for students and staff; and

WHEREAS, the Solar Panel Installation Project at the Transportation Center and the Winona Center (Project) was board approved on August 9, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Project involves the design and installation of solar panel systems, along with the related electrical and civil work at the District's Transportation Center and the Winona Center; and

WHEREAS, the California Public Resources Code Section 21080.35 provides a statutory exemption from CEQA for the installation of solar energy systems, including but not limited to photovoltaic panels, associated inverters, transformers, battery storage systems, and related electrical and civil work on existing rooftops, parking lots, and other facilities, provided the project does not involve the removal of protected trees or significant impacts to historical resources; and

WHEREAS, the District has reviewed the proposed project and determined that it meets the criteria for a statutory exemption under Public Resources Code Section 21080.35, as follows:

1. The Project consists of installing solar panel systems and the related electrical and civil work at the District's Transportation Center and the Winona Center; and
2. The Project does not require the removal of protected trees or result in significant impacts to historical resources; and

WHEREAS, District staff will file a Notice of Exemption (**Exhibit A**) with the Sacramento County Clerk and the State Clearinghouse in compliance with CEQA Guidelines Section 15062.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Twin Rivers Unified School District in Sacramento County, California, hereby issues this resolution that determines, declares, and resolves as follows:

1. The Project qualifies for a statutory exemption under Public Resources Code Section 21080.35.
2. The Project was board approved on August 9, 2023.
3. The Project is as described in the scope above.
4. The District considered whether the Project would have significant impact on the environment and determined that no such impact exists based on its review and analysis.
5. The District's Superintendent or designee thereof is directed to file the Notice of Exemption from CEQA consistent with this resolution, attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, with any and all appropriate public agencies or entities, subject only to minor, non-substantive revisions, if necessary.


