**NOTICE OF DETERMINATION
FOR THE ELECTRONIC SIGNS ON CITY-OWNED PROPERTY PROJECT
W. MISSION STREET AND MABURY ROAD SITES ADDENDUM (SCH #2025020244)**

Project Title: Electronic Signs on City-Owned Property Project – W. Mission Street and Mabury Road Sites Addendum

Project Description: The project consists of the installation and operation of two electronic billboards on two separate City-owned properties in accordance with Title 23 of the San José Municipal Code and Council Policy 6-4. One of the proposed billboards would be single-sided design with a north-facing display and the other would be a back-to-back design with north- and south-facing displays. The single-sided billboard would be approximately 60 feet in height, and the double-sided billboards would be approximately 85 feet in height. Operation hours of both signs would be as governed by City Council Policy 6-4, which are currently 6:00 a.m. to midnight; the signs would operate 7 days per week.

1. West Mission Street site: Southeast corner of SR 87 (Guadalupe Parkway) and West Mission Street, San José, CA, 95110
2. Mabury Road site: 1404 Mabury Road, San José, CA 95133

The City prepared an addendum to the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for this project in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and CEQA Guidelines. The addendum evaluated the nature and extent of any adverse effects on the environment that could occur if a project, as addended, is approved and implemented. The evaluation determined that the project would not have any new significant and unavoidable impact with the implementation of mitigation measures. Significant impacts were identified for Biological Resources, all of which could be mitigated to less than significant levels of impact.

This is to advise that the City Council of the City of San José approved the above-described project on **May 5, 2026** and made the following determinations regarding such project:

1. An Addendum was prepared and completed for this project pursuant to and in compliance with the provisions of CEQA.
2. The City Council has independently reviewed and analyzed the Addendum and other information in the record and has considered the information contained therein, prior to acting upon or approving the Project.
3. The Addendum represents the independent judgment and analysis of the City of San José, as lead agency for the Project.
4. This project will not have any new significant impacts on the environment.
5. Mitigation Measures were made a condition of the project.
6. A Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program was adopted for the project.
7. Findings were made and adopted for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
