The Project Site is located in the Hollywood Community Plan area along the Los Angeles (LA) River, specifically an approximately one-mile alignment along an existing paved equestrian trail/service road owned by the City of Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP). The eastern terminus of the alignment includes a locked gate which is also the western terminus of the existing Los Angeles River Bikeway segment to the east of the Project area, and the western terminus of the Project alignment is located approximately 200 feet east of the northern terminus of Forest Lawn Drive. The proposed Project would upgrade an existing equestrian trail/maintenance road to include a new section of the Los Angeles River Bikeway. The Project would construct a new asphalt concrete pavement Class I bicycle and pedestrian path along the south bank of the Los Angeles River adjacent to an existing equestrian trail. The Project would extend the Los Angeles River Bikeway by approximately one mile from its current western terminus near Riverside Drive and would improve the existing on-site equestrian trail facilities to maintain equestrian access between the Los Angeles Equestrian Center and Griffith Park. The proposed Project would facilitate future connections to the larger active transportation network throughout the region and provide improved pedestrian, bicycle, and equestrian access and connectivity to transit, residential homes, schools, jobs, parks, and other community-serving amenities for the surrounding communities. The proposed Project would add to the region's livability by expanding active transportation options and providing new facilities to promote access to public transit, homes, schools, work, parks, and other community-serving amenities.
