The County of Los Angeles (County), as Lead Agency pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), has prepared a Draft Program Environmental Impact Report (PEIR) for the proposed Los Angeles County Commercial Cannabis Business Licensing Program (Project). The County has prepared this Notice of Availability (NOA) to provide agencies, organizations, and other interested parties with sufficient information describing the proposed Project and its location, the potential environmental effects, information regarding the availability of the Draft PEIR for public review, and the timeline for submitting comments on the Draft PEIR.

All interested parties, including the public, responsible agencies, and trustee agencies, are invited to provide comments on the technical sufficiency of the environmental impact analysis provided in the Draft PEIR.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION/LOCATION: On February 15, 2022, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors directed relevant County departments to move forward with the development and implementation of Commercial Cannabis Business Licensing Program for unincorporated Los Angeles County. In accordance with this directive, the County of Los Angeles is proposing amendments to Title 22 (Zoning Ordinance Amendments) and Title 8 (Commercial Cannabis Administration Amendments) to allow for the permitting of legal commercial cannabis uses in eligible zone districts in unincorporated areas of Los Angeles County.



ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS ANALYZED: The Draft PEIR analyzed potential environmental impacts associated with the proposed Project:

- Air Quality
- Energy
- Greenhouse Gas Emissions
- Hazards & Hazardous Materials
- Land Use/Planning
- Transportation
- Utilities/Service Systems

The PEIR identified significant and unavoidable impacts related to Transportation. Impacts to Air Quality, Energy, Greenhouse Gas Emissions, Hazards & Hazardous Materials, Land Use/Planning, and Utilities/Service Systems would be less than significant and mitigation measures would not be required.
