Project Title: Western Joshua Tree Hazard Management Permit Program

Project Location: The Western Joshua Tree Hazard Management Permit Program issues hazard management permits for specified types of take of western Joshua tree throughout its range. The range of western Joshua tree includes part or all of the following counties: Inyo, Kern, Los Angeles, Mono, Ventura, Riverside, Tulare, San Bernardino.

Project Description: Pursuant to the Western Joshua Tree Conservation Act (Fish & G. Code, § 1927.4), CDFW is authorized to issue permits (hazard management permits) to take dead western Joshua trees and to trim living western Joshua trees if the western Joshua tree in question: (1) has fallen over and is within 30 feet of a structure; (2) is leaning against an existing structure; or (3) creates an imminent threat to public health or safety. CDFW typically issues hazard management permits for the take of 1-5 western Joshua trees. The most common scenarios for the issuance of hazard management permits are for: (1) removal of dead and detached trees; (2) removal of dead and detached limbs; (3) trimming living trees; (4) trimming and removing dead and attached trees; and (5) removing dead and detached crowns and trimming and removing dead and attached trunks. CDFW issues several hundred hazard management permits annually.
