Project Title: Minor Alteration No. WA2025051 - Miller Regional Park Marina Boat Launch Project

Project Applicant: City of Sacramento

Project Location: The project is located on the left bank of the Sacramento River approximately 500 feet south of the Marina's entrance in Sacramento County (38.56011°N, 121.51642°W).

Project Description: To repair cracks and missing concrete at the boat launch with cement, repair two floating dock floats each consisting of four 8-by-20-foot sections, replace float dock cables and anchors, and install rip rap alongside the upstream edge of the boat launch by excavating perimeter trenches 3-to-5 feet wide and a minimum of 18 inches deep, laying down a geotextile filter cloth, and placing the rip rap at a 4:1 slope matching the top of the rip rap with the finished grade of the boat launch.

Reasons Why Project is Exempt:

The project is exempt from CEQA under the Class 1, Existing Facilities categorical exemption (CEQA California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15301), because the activity consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use. No expansion of existing or former use will occur. The project is exempt from CEQA under the Class 2, Replacement or Reconstruction categorical exemption (CEQA California Code of Regulations, Title 14, 15302), because the activity consists of replacement and reconstruction of an existing structure in the same site and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the replaced structure. Further, none of the exceptions to the exemption in CEQA California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15300.2 apply.
