The Hearst Forests Subsequent CAL FIRE PTEIR project includes revisions to the project site and operational activities analyzed in CALFIRE's 1998 PTEIR. The project site is proposed to be expanded by approximately 20,010 acres to a total of 80,989 acres to encompass properties purchased by Hearst Forest in 2023. Non-commercial fuel reduction activities including the creation of fuel breaks especially in areas adjacent to critical infrastructure and the WUI are being added. Silviculture prescriptions will be expanded to enable timber management and fuel reduction to protect late-seral stand conditions and reduce wildfire risk. Best Management Practices will be updated to reflect current regulatory requirements. Adaptive programmatic mitigation agreements of other agencies will be incorporated into the PTEIR. Late-Seral Management Zone (LSMZ) area boundaries will be realigned to remove the limited areas that do not possess LSMZ characteristics and better align with LSMZ objectives. McCloud Preserve boundaries will be realigned and enhanced to simplify operations and enhance the protection of Preserve areas, resulting in a net increase of Preserve acres within the ownership.
