Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The Applicant proposes the Seville 5 Solar Project which consists of the development of a 65-Megawatt (MW) solar photovoltaic energy generation facility, 130-MW battery energy storage system, and a gen-tie line to an existing substation immediately south of the project site with ultimate delivery to Imperial Irrigation District's existing 92-kV "K" Line.

Biological Resources: Special-status plant and wildlife have the potential to occur within or near the project site, the project site also contains jurisdictional aquatic resources and sensitive vegetation communities. Implementation of Mitigation Measures BIO-1 through BIO-25 would reduce potential impacts.

Geology and Soils: Ground-disturbing activities associated with the project may impact geologic units of relatively high paleontological sensitivity. implementation of Mitigation Measures GEO-1 through GEO-5 would reduce potential impacts.
