**PROJECT TITLE:** ROE to Smith River Alliance

**LOCATION:** Jedediah Smith Redwoods State Park **COUNTY:** Del Norte

**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:** Issue a Right of Entry (ROE) to the Smith River Alliance for access to the upper portion of the Elk Creek Watershed in Jedediah Smith Redwoods State Park for the purposes of upgrading two (2) existing undersized and failing culverts. One (1) culvert will be replaced with a new culvert and one (1) will be replaced with a prefabricated bridge. The new culvert and bridge will have the capacity to withstand 100-year floods, restore natural stream function, and improve fish passage.

All work conducted pursuant to this ROE will comply with all state and federal environmental laws, including but not limited to CEQA, NEPA, the Endangered Species Act, Section 5024 of the Public Resources Code, and conditions specified by this ROE and other permitting agencies.
