Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

San Luis Concrete Corp. (Applicant) is proposing to develop seven single-family residences, a 0.42-acre-foot retention basin, paved site access driveway and cul-de-sac, and other associated on-site improvements on a 2.51-acre property and off-site improvements along the property frontage within the City of Hesperia, California. The project site consists of eight total lots ranging from 7,210 to 13,924 square feet in size. The lot located in the northeastern corner of the project site would be developed with a proposed 0.42-acre-foot stormwater retention basin, while the remaining seven lots would be developed with residential single-family uses.

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

Biological Resources: The project has the potential to disturb biological resources, including but not limited to Western Joshua Trees located on the project site. Mitigation has been identified to obtain a City-approved project biologist to ensure compliance with biological resource mitigations measures, Construction General Pest Practices, and to consult with CDFW to obtain WJTCA permit(s) if ground disturbance is unavoidable.

Cultural Resources: The project has the potential for the inadvertent discovery of unknown archaeological resources within the project site. Mitigation has been identified to retain a qualified archaeologist to assess any potential finds.

Tribal Cultural Resources: The project has the potential for the inadvertent discovery of unknown cultural resources within the project site. Mitigation has been identified to ensure the Yuhaaviatam of San Manuel Nation Cultural Resources Department (YSMN) is contacted if any pre-contact cultural resources are discovered during project implementation. YSMN will be provided information regarding the nature of the find to provide Tribal input with regards to significance and treatment and all records and reports will be documented and submitted to the City and YSMN.
