DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: The project will perform geotechnical investigations to aid in the design of a new parking lot/Arroyo Plaza/Grove House, pedestrian bridge, packing house/workshop, and bunk house with associated site improvements. The work will include approximately 5-6 exploratory borings up to 50 feet at each site (total of 20-24 borings) within park property.
