Project Title: Permit No. 19904 - Ground Mounted 158.595kW Solar Array Butte Basin Project

Project Applicant: Christensen Keyawa LLC

Project Location: The project is located approximately 5,000 feet west of River Road and 6,200 feet north of Ord Ferry Road, at 39.64053°N 121.96356°W, Butte Basin, Butte County.

Project Description: To install a 158.595kW solar photovoltaic ground mounted with 3-foot by 1-foot pier footings to power an agricultural pump connected by an underground electrical trench located within the Butte Basin. A new solar AC disconnect will be installed on the existing main service line and panel.

Reasons Why Project is Exempt:

The Board has determined that the project is exempt from CEQA under the Class 3, New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures categorical exemption (CEQA California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15303), because the activity consists of construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures; installation of small new equipment and facilities in small structures; and the conversion of existing small structures from one use to another where only minor modifications are made in the exterior of the structure. The project is also exempt from CEQA under the Class 4, Minor Alterations to Land categorical exemption (CEQA California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15304), because the activity consists of minor public or private alterations in the condition of land, water, and/or vegetation which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees except for forestry or agricultural purposes. Further, none of the exceptions to the exemption in CEQA California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15300.2 apply.
