Project Title: 3421 Highway 147-Outbuilding (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. PLU-55980-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at an unnamed tributary to Lake Almanor, in the County of Plumas, State of California; Latitude 40.21298, Longitude 121.06699, 3421 Highway 147, Lake Almanor, CA.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number PLU-55980-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Bryan Gibbons.

The project consists of the construction of an outbuilding on a steel I-beam platform straddling the unnamed tributary to Lake Almanor. The platform is supported on both sides of the stream channel by attachment to a pre-existing, reinforced concrete slab (foundation of existing house) and a previously, poured in place, concrete pad.
