Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

Upgrade valves, piping, and controls to the existing flocculant and filter basins, rerouting the analyzer waste, installing a retaining wall for improved valve access, bringing all subsurface valves above ground level, adding a third reclaim backwash tank, and improving existing fencing to improve site security.

Reasons why project is exempt:

The Project consists of the replacement of existing valves, construction of a third backwash reclaim tank, and utility infrastructure that supports treatment within the existing permitted capacity of the Tanner WTP, with negligible or no expansion of capacity from the existing WTP site use. No exceptions to the application of these exemptions have been identified. The Project would be consistent with the existing land uses, on a developed and highly disturbed site, with limited construction scope, no increase in staffing or operational trips, consistent with the height and use limitations requirements from the ALUC, and would operate within the Tanner WTP's existing permitted capacity. Due to the limited extent of the Project, absence of impact to nearby sensitive receptors, absence of significant air quality, noise, biological resources, land use, traffic, VMT or water quality impacts, the AWA use of the "common sense" exemption per CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3) is appropriate.
