Project Title: Cali Fire Farms LLC; DCC24-0031 (Project)

Project Location: The Project is located at 3007 Howard Road, San Andreas (APN 040-008-076) in Calaveras County.

County: Calaveras County

Project Description: The Department of Cannabis Control, pursuant to authority granted under Business and Profession Code, Division 10, Chapter 2, Section 26012, approved a Medium Outdoor commercial cannabis license.

Project Activities: The Project will consist of 42,000 square feet (SF) of mature outdoor cannabis canopy. Land use of the parcel is Agricultural (zoned A1 and is 112.28 acres). Irrigation water is provided by an onsite groundwater well with four water storage tanks. Electricity is provided by PG&E. During the growing season, there will be 1) 1-2 workers on site every day and 2) no more than 2-3 trips on/off the facility each day related to cannabis operations from approximately 7 am to 6 pm five (5) days a week. Cultivation operations will not generate hazardous waste. Solid waste and stored cannabis waste will be self-hauled to the County Landfill located in Milton as needed. There will be no irrigation or wastewater discharges outside of the cultivation area.

Reasons Why Project is Exempt: The Department of Cannabis Control has determined that the project is consistent with the local jurisdiction community plan and/or zoning designations. Calaveras County Board of Supervisors certified an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the Medical Cannabis Cultivation and Commerce Ordinance Project in January 2018. CEQA mandates that the project is consistent with the development density established by existing zoning, community plan, or general plan policies for which an EIR was certified and shall not require additional environmental review, except as might be necessary to examine whether there are project-specific significant effects which are peculiar to the project or its site. The project activity fits within the parameters included in CEQA Guidelines Section 15183 and the activity does not require additional CEQA analysis.
