Project Location: The project is located along the right (north) bank of the San Joaquin River, at 14054 Crows Landing Road in San Joaquin County.

Project Description: To authorize; an existing 16-foot wide gate, existing fruit trees and agricultural fields located more than 10 feet from the waterside levee toe, an existing water storage tank, an existing pump on the waterside berm, existing irrigation lines to waterside farming, an existing 4.5-foot by 5.5-foot concrete vault, and an existing 14-inch diameter PVC pipe, existing ramps along the landside and waterside levee slopes as shown in levee as-constructed drawing 7-4-1555 STA 286+05 & 286+25, an existing 12-inch diameter concrete drainage pipe and distribution box as shown in levee as-constructed drawing 7-4-1555 STA 281+33.
