Notice of Intent to Adopt a Negative Declaration for a Culvert Rehabilitation and Fish Passage project

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes a Culvert Rehabilitation and Fish Passage Project on U.S. Highway 101 between Post Miles M0.0 and 46.5 in Del Norte County. The project would rehabilitate 20 drainage systems and remediate fish passage at two of the locations.

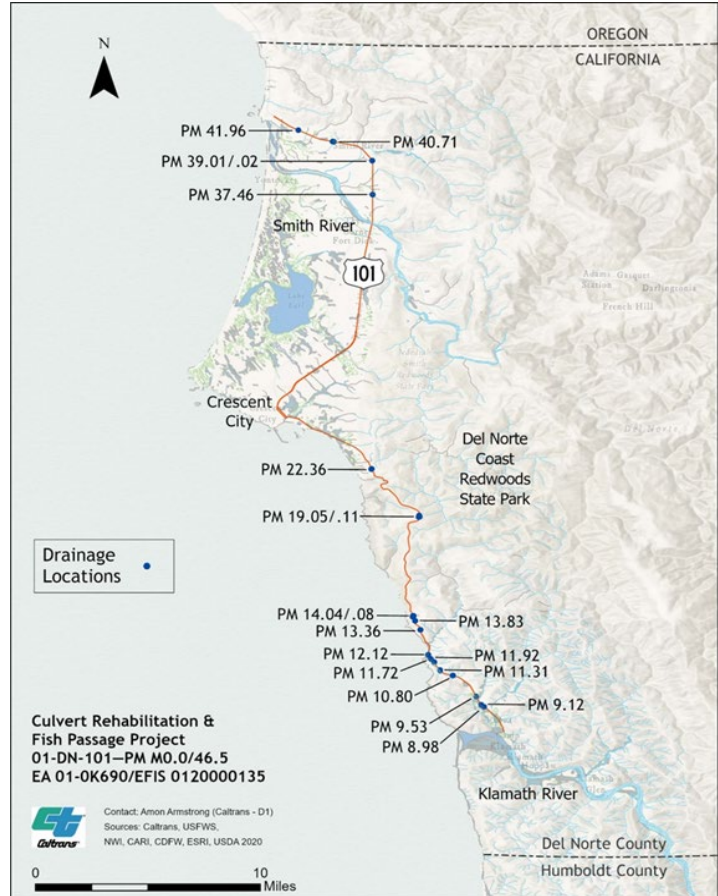
WHAT IS AVAILABLE?
