Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

Caltrans proposes to replace two culverts on I-80 at post mile 23.90. The culverts are located on the on/off-ramp to Lagoon Valley Regional Park. The culverts are part of a drainage system consisting of earthen ditch conveying flow to areas leading into Lagoon Valley Park. Work is limited to replacing the two 18" culverts by cut and cover method. Construction equipment to be used includes, but is not limited to, asphalt concrete trucks, grinders, loaders, pavers, and rollers. One-way traffic control will be required during construction. All construction work will remain within Caltrans right of way and be adjacent to the roadway.
