**DESCRIPTION OF NATURE,
PURPOSE, AND
BENEFICIARIES OF PROJECT**

TinderSmart Tehama: Phase III (Project) will integrate several proactive hazardous fuel reduction strategies to treat 720 acres across urban, woodland, shrubland, and forested landscapes in several communities in Moderate, High, and Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zones throughout Tehama County (SRA & LRA).

The purpose of the project is to enable the RCDTC and its' partners to provide defensible space assistance around homes and to conduct vegetative fuels reduction in drainages and sloughs, which will help reduce wildfire intensity and rate of spread to protect people, property, infrastructure, and habitat within wildfire threatened communities in Tehama County.

This multi-component Project was developed in collaboration with the Resource Conservation District of Tehama County (RCDTC), Red Bluff Fire Department (Rbfd), and several Fire Safe Councils and Firewise communities to prioritize management needs. The Project is composed of several sub components including: Component A is a continuation of the RCDTC's Defensible Space Assistance program, which will create defensible space for 375 properties/acres across the county; Component B consists of 60 acres of hand thinning in drainages in Lake California; Component C covers 50 acres of mastication and hand thinning along roadsides in Manton; Component D includes 50 acres of mastication and hand thinning in Paynes Creek Slough; Component E comprises 50 acres of mastication and hand thinning in East Sand Slough and Samson Slough; and Component F consists of 135 acres of mastication and hand thinning by the Rbfd and Ishi Conservation Camp crews in drainages within Red Bluff City limits. Vegetative fuels will be treated using an array of methods such as chipping, mastication, herbicide and hand thinning.

Project Locations – Please see map for more specific locations.

- Component A: Defensible Space Assistance: Various households located in WUI communities and SRA throughout Tehama County.
- Component B: Lake California Drainages: Drainages and vegetated land adjacent to and surrounding Lake Ca POA land and community in North – Central Tehama County.
- Component C: Manton Roadside Fuel Break: roadsides in and around Manton WUI Community located in Northeastern Tehama County.
- Component D: Paynes Creek Slough Fuel Reduction: Paynes Creek Slough located East of Red Bluff, Ca near Antelope Blvd.
- Component E: East Sand Slough and Samson Slough Maintenance: Samson Slough and East Sand Slough drainages East of Red Bluff, Ca adjacent to Antelope Blvd.
- Component F: City of Red Bluff Drainages: urban drainages inundated within City of Red Bluff limits – Situated East and Southeast of Red Bluff, Ca.

Beneficiaries of project will include various residents and stakeholders of Tehama County as well as TCPW and RBFD.
