Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The proposed Desert Valley Hospital Emergency Department & Medical Surgery Building Addition Project consists of the construction of a new two-story building addition to the existing Desert Valley Hospital. The building addition would include a new Emergency Department (ED) on the first floor and a new Medical-Surgical Department (Med Surg Unit) on the second floor. As part of the project, a new service yard would be provided on site to accommodate utilities for the building addition. On-site and off-site improvements are planned as part of the project to accommodate additional parking spaces and efficient traffic flow. The purpose of this project is to provide a new ED for the facility to address the needs of the hospital and community. Specifically, the building addition would provide an opportunity to create capacity for current and future demand, as well as to resolve the challenges and deficiencies in the existing departments.
