Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

WSID will make up to 3,200 AF of Central Valley Project water available to Lower Tule River Irrigation District and up to 8,600 AF of CVP water available to Pixley Irrigation District conveyed through the Delta-Mendota Canal and San Luis Reservoir in 2025. This transfer is well within the historical actions taken by West Stanislaus with respect to water transfers.
