Project Title: TD1478706 Old Mammoth Autumn 12kV Deteriorated Pole Replacement Project (Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, No. EPIMS-1600-2019-0251-R6)

Project Location (Mono County): TD1478706 Old Mammoth Autumn 12kV Deteriorated Pole Replacement Project (project) is located on privately-owned lands along an unnamed wetland tributary to the Owens River approximately 270 feet south of Connell Street and 210 feet north of Old Mammoth Road within Mammoth Lakes, Mono County, State of California; Latitude 37.628987, Longitude -118.990891.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has amended Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-1600-2019-0251-R6, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Southern California Edison.

The amended project involves one ground rod replacement, one plate anchor replacement, and one anchor installation at Pole 2055470E and one plate anchor installation at Pole 424999S.

Amended project activities described above will increase temporary impacts from 0.01 acre to 0.024 acres and add 0.0046 acre of permanent impacts to resources subject to Fish and Game Code Section 1602.


