Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The project proposes to stabilize the roadway from PM 12.69 to PM 12.95 with a modified alignment and construction of retaining walls. Approximately 1,400 feet of U.S. 101 would be realigned (immediately north of the Wilson Creek Bridge) by increasing the curve radius from 1,050 feet to 1,732 feet, shifting the alignment approximately 30 feet east. Two retaining walls would be constructed to stabilize the roadway beginning at the north end of the Wilson Creek Bridge: a 695-foot-long by 55-foot-high soldier pile ground anchor (SPGA) wall along the western shoulder below the highway, and a 595-foot-long by 19-foot-high soil nail wall (SNW) along the eastern shoulder.
