Project Title: TD2026903 and TD2026905 Allison Ranch Road Grid Resiliency Project (Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, No. EPIMS-SBR-47737-R6)

Project Location (San Bernardino County): TD2026903 and TD2026905 Allison Ranch Road Grid Resiliency Project (project) is located within Shake Creek, Cedar Creek and Sheep Creek, all tributary to Deep Creek, approximately 3 miles east of the town of Lake Arrowhead, County of San Bernardino, State of California.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-SBR-47737-R6, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Southern California Edison.

The project is limited to removing and replacing five wooden distribution poles (Poles 4512122E, 4547062E, and X15157E [TD2026905] and Poles 4773398E and 4903061E [TD2026903]).

Project activities described above are anticipated to permanently impact 0.0001 acre and temporarily impact 0.59 acres of resources subject to Fish and Game Code Section 1602.


