Glenn County is located in the Northern Central Valley. The County has two incorporated cities (City of Orland and City of Willows) and nine unincorporated communities. The purpose of the plan is to provide a transportation vision for the region, supported by goals, for 10- and 20-year planning horizons. This is accomplished by identifying transportation related needs and issues on a regional level, reaffirming the regions goals, objectives, and policies, developing a list of improvements to the transportation system that meet the identified needs and prioritizing these improvements to the transportation system that meet the identified needs and prioritizing these improvements so as to create a financially constrained plan. The RTP does not directly provide for the implementation of transportation projects and/or facilities, it identifies necessary improvements in order to provide the best possible circulation/transportation system to meet the mobility needs of the entire county.
