Project Title: Murray Creek Maintenance (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. CAL-60144-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at Murray Creek, in the County of Calaveras, State of California; Latitude 38.20704, Longitude -120.69787 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees); 1113 Highway 49 San Andreas, CA, 95249; Assessor's Parcel Number 040-012-032-000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number CAL-60144 -R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, John Dunlap/MACT Health. The project is limited to the clearing of blackberry bushes, fallen trees, and other debris which limits the channel capacity of Murray Creek in an approximately 400 linear feet area (4800 square feet).

Class 4 because the maintenance activities are limited to minor alterations to the land and water and will not have any adverse impacts to special-status species or their habitats.
