Project Description

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to upgrade crosswalks and place Red Reflective Pavement Markers at 34 locations along various routes throughout Glenn, Butte, Sutter, and Yolo Counties. The purpose of this project is to improve safety for pedestrians and prevent future collisions between motorists. The project is needed because the current offramp and intersection locations include minimal preventive measures to avoid future pedestrian-motorist related collisions. The existing crosswalks will be restriped to a ladder type pattern, which makes the crosswalks and pedestrians more visible to motorists. Red Reflective Pavement Markers will also be installed at the same locations. Ramp closures and night work will be anticipated. In some locations roadway signs may be installed or replaced.
