Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The scope of work includes furnishing materials, labor, tools, transportation, and services to install approximately 1,900 linear feet of 8-inch ductile iron water main in the subsurface street corridor (San Gabriel Ave and Willard St). The new water main would connect to existing water utility infrastructure and serves the needs of existing development. The work site is located in the City of Long Beach, California on San Gabriel Ave between Williams St and Willard St, and on Willard St between San Gabriel Ave and Williams St.

Reasons why project is exempt:

The minor alterations to land include limited excavation and shallow depth trenching. No trees would be removed as part of this work. The surface conditions would be restored to paved areas.
