Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The scope of work includes furnishing materials, labor, tools, transportation, and services to install approximately 333 linear feet of 6-inch ductile iron water main in the subsurface street corridor (Rose Avenue). The purpose of the project is to improve fire flow conditions to nearby fire hydrants. The work site is located in the City of Long Beach, California on Rose Avenue between Plymouth Street and 53rd Street. The new water main would connect to existing water utility infrastructure and serves the needs of existing development.

Reasons why project is exempt:

The project includes the installation of new water infrastructure that would connect into an existing utility system. The construction of limited new lineal feet of water main infrastructure would serve the existing service population and supports the continued operation of existing water pipelines. The minor alterations to land include limited excavation and shallow depth trenching. No trees would be removed as part of this work. The surface conditions would be restored to paved areas.

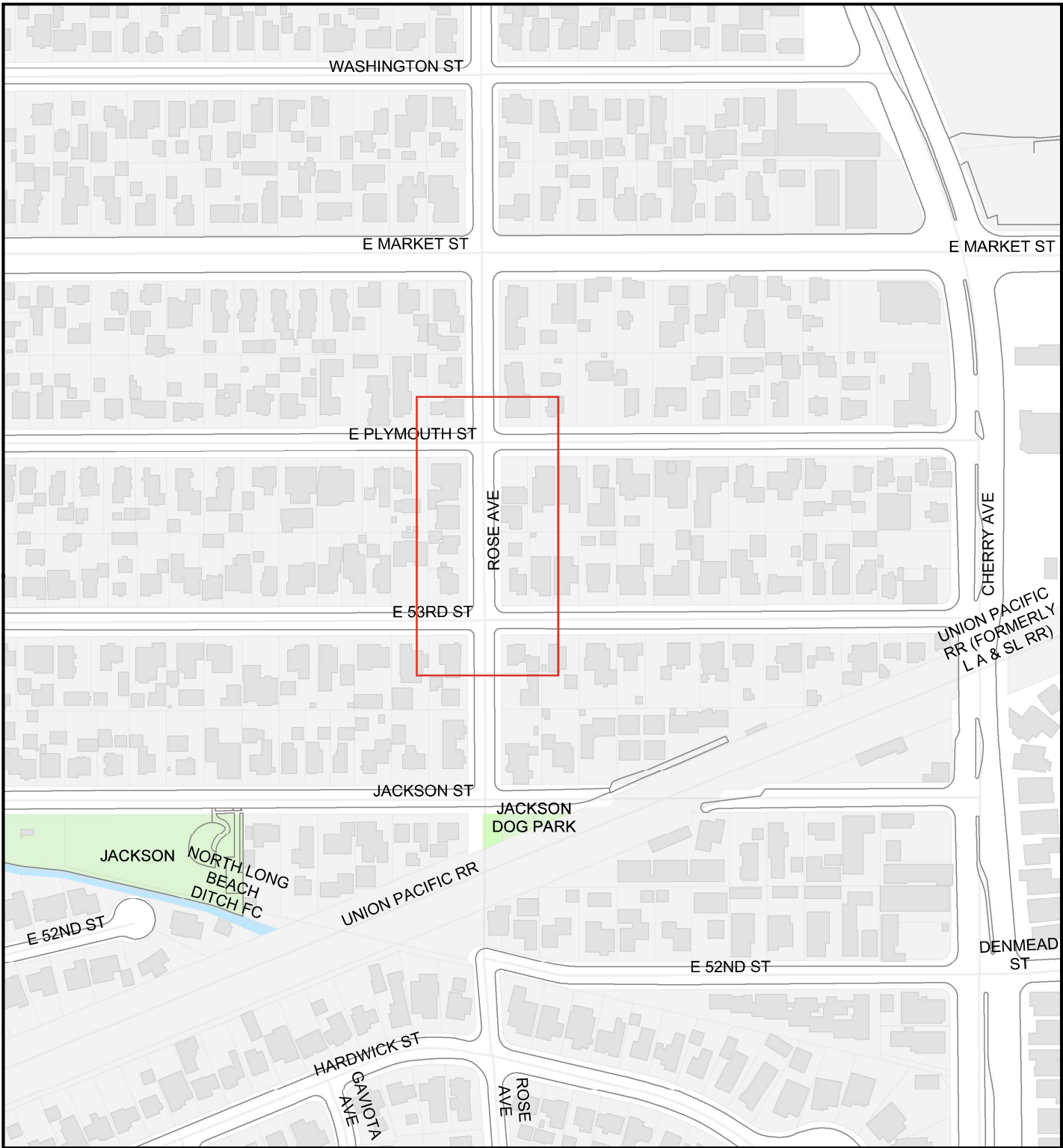

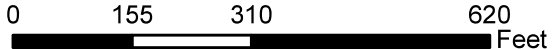
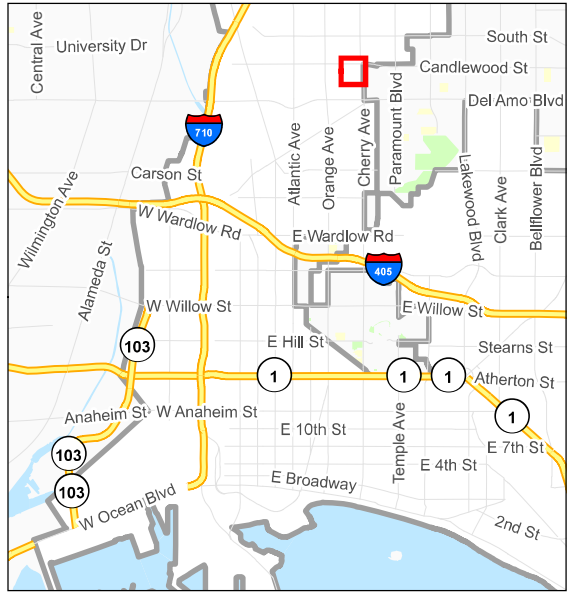
