Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The Project will include the demolition of a majority of the existing buildings. Six new buildings would be constructed, including a two-story Administration and General Classroom building; a one-story Food Services and Multi-Purpose Room building; a one- to two-story Science Labs and General Classrooms building; a one-story Student Life building, a one story Career and Technical Education and classrooms building, and a one-story Career and Technical Education and Music classrooms building. In addition, the existing Auditorium and Gymnasium, would be internally renovated. The Project would remove existing asphalt areas, and sports court/field and landscaping improvements would be included throughout the Inglewood High School campus. In addition, the Project would include campus path lighting, exterior building lights, and sports facility lighting.

Due to the addition of lighting on campus, including field and sports court lighting, the lighting and glare will be analyzed in the EIR.

Building demolition, including the demolition of Buildings A, I, and M have the potential to impact an eligible historic resource. In addition, ground-disturbing activities could have the potential to encounter archaeological and paleontological resources. Therefore, cultural resources will be analyzed in the EIR.

Due to construction impacts, air quality impacts will also be analyzed in the EIR.

In addition, due to potential construction and operational impacts, energy, greenhouse gas emissions, and noise will also be analyzed in the EIR.

Transportation impacts associated with the Project will be analyzed in the EIR.

Due to ground-disturbing activities, impacts to Tribal Cultural Resources will also be analyzed in the EIR.
