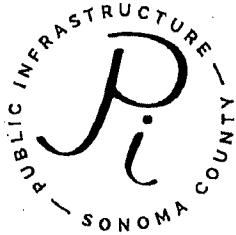

NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

Sonoma County proposes to carry out the following project. Pursuant to Section 23A-11 of the Sonoma County Code, it has been determined that this project is statutorily and categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA):

Project Title: Winter Storms 2024-25 Damaged Site – West Soda Rock Lane

Lead Agency / County Agency of Filing: Sonoma County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The County of Sonoma has proposed the 2024-25 storm damage repair project at West Soda Rock Lane (Postmile 12.60), located near Healdsburg, California. The Project will be funded by local funds and undertaken by the Sonoma County Department of Public Infrastructure. The purpose of the Project is to repair the portion of West Soda Rock Lane at approximately PM 12.60 that failed during the 2024-25 storms and flooding. The County proposes to repair approximately 100 feet of roadway along West Soda Rock Lane.

The project proposes to construct storm damage slide repair work along West Soda Rock Lane at PM 12.60. The work includes reconstructing the downslope roadway embankment by excavating native soil and establishing subgrade benching, placing rock slope protection and fabric, placing grouted rock slope protection, a fully grouted keyway, and finally reconstructing the roadway structural section of aggregate base and asphalt concrete and other items of work needed to restore the road to a functional condition. The project has 45 working days, which is a construction duration of roughly 2-1/2 months.

EXEMPT STATUS:

Statutory Exemption(s). 15269 [Emergency Projects]

Categorical Exemption(s). 15301 [Existing Facilities], 15302 [Replacement or Reconstruction]

REASONS WHY THIS PROJECT IS EXEMPT:

The proposed project is statutorily exempt from environmental review pursuant to section 15269 [Emergency Projects] and categorically exempt from environmental review pursuant to Sections 15301 [Existing Facilities] and 15302 [Replacement or Reconstruction] of the Guidelines for Implementation of CEQA. Section 15269(b) exempts emergency repairs to publicly or privately owned service facilities necessary to maintain service essential to the public health, safety or welfare. Section 15269(c) exempts specific actions necessary to prevent or mitigate an emergency. Section 15269(d) exempts projects undertaken, carried out, or approved by a public agency to maintain, repair, or restore an existing highway damaged by fire, flood, storm, earthquake, land subsidence, gradual earth movement, or landslide, provided

that the project is within the existing right of way of that highway and is initiated within one year of the damage occurring. Section 15301(c) exempts the repair or minor alteration of existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities. Section 15302(c) exempts the replacement or reconstruction of existing utility systems and/or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of capacity. No exceptions listed under Section 15300.2 apply. There is no reasonable possibility that the project would have a significant effect on the environment.

This Notice of Exemption is filed pursuant to the provisions of Section 15062 of the State CEQA Guidelines.
