Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

The Project proposes restoring meadow floodplain function and water table elevation within the 212-acre area of McKenzie Meadows. Restoration activities will include partial channel fill, rock riffles, sod riffles, and removal of several sections of old railroad grade/berm that are negatively impacting water flow through the meadow.
