Project Title: TD1967094 Emigrant Street Deteriorated Pole Replacement Project (Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, No. EPIMS-MOO-51723-R6)

Project Location (Mono County): TD1967094 Emigrant Street Deteriorated Pole Replacement Project (project) is located within an unnamed stream, tributary to East Walker River, approximately 2 miles west of the town of Bridgeport, County of Mono, State of California.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-MOO-51723-R6, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Southern California Edison.

The project is limited to removing and replacing 26 wood utility poles with new wood poles set in plastic sonotubes.

Project activities described above are anticipated to impact 0.248 acres of resources subject to Fish and Game Code Section 1602.
