Project Location (Tulare County): The Project will occur within Lake Isabella, approximately 1.10 miles north of the Isabella Dam, south of Wofford Heights Boulevard, approximately 1.75 miles northwest of the census designated place of Lake Isabella, Kern County, State of California; Coordinates 35.66068, -118.47422.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement Notification No. EPIMS-KER-57998-R4, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code, to Southern California Edison Company.
