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**Project Title:** TD1963193 and TD2080534 Mill Creek Powerhouse Road Grid Resiliency Project (Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, No. EPIMS-MOO-53926-R6)

**Project Location (Mono County):** TD1963193 and TD2080534 Mill Creek Powerhouse Road Grid Resiliency Project (project) is located within an unnamed stream and unnamed wetlands, both tributary to Wilson Creek, approximately 0.75-mile northwest of the unincorporated Mono City, County of Mono, State of California.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-MOO-53926-R6, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Southern California Edison.

The project is limited to removing and replacing three wood utility poles with new wood poles and replacing two plate anchors at Pole 4824427E with screw anchors.

Project activities described above are anticipated to impact 0.45 acres of resources subject to Fish and Game Code Section 1602.
