Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

This project will install 2,000 feet of 12 inch irrigation pipeline. This project will install one well of common local size with an electrical platform and electrical service to the well. Included with the pipeline is an irrigation screen filter and one point of connection to an existing irrigation system. The pipeline will be trenched in existing vineyard road. The average depth of trench is 4.5 feet. Surfaces will be restored to pre-project like condition and there will be no net fill of project materials on site. The purpose of this project is to supply water for groundwater recharge through existing irrigation systems.

Reasons why project is exempt:

The project is exempt under the category 15061, Existing Facilities, Example (b) because the pipeline and appurtenant facilities are consistent with standard agricultural irrigation systems and will be installed entirely within existing vineyard roads. The work will not result in any land use changes or significant environmental effects. The pipe and pump infrastructure is exempt under 15303, New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures, Example (b) because the well pump structures are subject to a Riparian Zoning permit, Example (d) due to the small size and limited number of pump housing structures, and Example (f) because there will be minor trenching for pipeline placement within existing vineyard roads. The interconnection into existing on-farm sprinklers and water application systems is exempt under 15301, Existing Facilities, because it involves minor alterations to existing private structures and infrastructure. The project is also exempt under 15306, Information Collection, because it is an investigative pilot project focused on basic data gathering and research, and will not result in a serious or major disturbance to an environmental resource.
