

RESOLUTION NO. 1546

MAKING CERTAIN DETERMINATIONS RELATED TO THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT AND AUTHORIZING STAFF TO FILE A NOTICE OF EXEMPTION FOR THE GRANT UNION HIGH SCHOOL EXTERIOR PAINT, WINDOW REPLACEMENT AND SINGLE POINT OF ENTRY FENCING PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Twin Rivers Unified School District (“District”) is committed to maintaining and improving school facilities to ensure safe, functional, and sustainable learning environments for students and staff; and

WHEREAS, the Grant Union High School Exterior Paint, Window Replacement and Single Point of Entry Fencing Project (“Project”) was board approved on August 12, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Project involves facility improvements including the replacement of existing wood windows with new windows, and exterior painting of buildings and structures in accordance with plan specifications. The project also includes facility improvements to establish single point of entry access to the campus; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (“CEQA”) (Pub. Resources Code, § 21000 et seq.) and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 CCR § 15000 et seq.) require public agencies to evaluate the environmental impacts of proposed projects before approving them; and

WHEREAS, the District has determined that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA under one or more applicable exemptions as set forth in the CEQA Guidelines, as described below:

Class 1 Exemption (Section 15301): Applies to the operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing facilities, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that previously existing; and

WHEREAS, there is no evidence of any unusual circumstances or significant environmental impacts that would preclude the use of this Class 1 Categorical Exemption under CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(1-5); and

WHEREAS, District staff or designee will file a Notice of Exemption and required supporting documents (**Exhibit A**) with the Sacramento County Clerk and the State Clearinghouse in compliance with CEQA Guidelines Section 15062.
