**ALBERT BIELLA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL MODERNIZATION PROJECT
CEQA NOTICE OF EXEMPTION DISCUSSION**

Project Description

Existing Facilities

Albert F. Biella Elementary School, located at 2140 Jennings Ave., Santa Rosa, is part of Santa Rosa City Schools. The school has a current enrollment of approximately 290 students.

The school is in the northwestern area of Santa Rosa, and is bordered by single-family residences. The primary access to the school is off of Jennings Avenue.

Proposed Project

The project would consist of site improvements and new play yards, reconfiguration and interior modernization of Building C kindergarten classrooms, interior reconfiguration and modernization of Building E classroom pod, and interior reconfiguration and modernization of two Building F portables at the existing school. Bathrooms in those buildings also would be remodeled. Three new play areas would be developed in the existing school courtyard, including a kindergarten-specific playground. Exterior doors also would be replaced. The parking area would be reconfigured to have 46 standard stalls and 2 accessible stalls, and landscaped with trees and shrubs. New ADA-accessible ramps and drop-off facilities would be added to the parking area and school grounds. New fencing would be added. Eight landscape trees would be removed as part of the project.

The project would be constructed over a 8-month period from January 2026 - August 2026.

Categorical Exemption Analysis

Class 1 Exemption

The CEQA Class 1 Exemption (Class 1-Existing Facilities [CEQA Guidelines, Section 15301]) applies to operation and minor expansions of existing facilities. It includes upgrades of existing building interiors and exteriors, demolition and removal of small structures, addition of safety or health protection devices, restoration or rehabilitation of deteriorated structures, and additions to existing structures that will not result in an increase of more than 50% of the floor area before the addition, or 2500 sq. ft., whichever is less.

The proposed project would consist of interior, landscaping, and parking lot modifications, and construction of new play areas and ADA access improvements in an existing school campus. No additional building footage would be constructed. Therefore, this exemption would apply to the project.

Exceptions to the Exemption

Per CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, exceptions to this categorical exemption can apply where the following occur:

- Cumulative impact of the same type in the same place, over time is significant.
- Damage to scenic resources, including but not limited to, trees, historic buildings, rock outcroppings, or similar resources, within a state scenic highway.
- Hazardous Waste Sites included on any list compiled pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.
- A substantial adverse change in the significance of a historical resource.
- Significant effect due to unusual circumstances.

As summarized below, none of these exceptions appear to apply to this project and therefore these exemptions would apply:

- The project is not located in a sensitive area.
- The project area is in a developed school campus, and no cumulative development is likely to occur nearby.
- Construction would be on an existing school campus, and exterior work would be limited new play areas, landscaping, parking lot, and access improvements, which would have minimal visual impacts. Trees proposed for removal will be replaced with new trees in the project landscape plan. Therefore no significant impact to visual resources is expected.
- The site is not on or near a listed hazardous waste site (database search performed August 6, 2025) ¹
- The proposed project would include interior modifications of modern structures, and would not demolish or substantially alter any historic structures. Therefore no historic resources would be affected.
- There do not appear to be any unusual circumstances that could result in significant environmental impacts at the site.
