(Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, No. EPIMS-RIV-56693-R6)

Project Location (Riverside County): TD2061417 Mead Valley Deteriorated Pole Replacement Project (project) is located on privately-owned lands along an unnamed stream tributary to Lake Mathews directly south of Cajalco Road in the census-designated place of Mead Valley, Riverside County, State of California; Latitude 33.83668, Longitude -117.32011.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-RIV-56693-R6, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Southern California Edison.

The project is limited to removing and replacing two wood utility poles (Poles 213262S and 2307369E) with new wood poles.

Project activities described above are anticipated to temporarily impact 0.029 acre of resources subject to Fish and Game Code Section 1602.
