Project Location (San Bernardino County): TD2005867 Anaheim Avenue Deteriorated Pole Replacement Project (project) is located on privately-owned lands within the Eureka Wash approximately 1.34 miles southwest of Parker Dam and approximately 1.27 miles west of Arizona State Route 95, San Bernardino County, State of California; Latitude 34.28193, Longitude -114.15492.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-SBR-55794-R6, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Southern California Edison.

The project is limited to removing and replacing one wood utility pole (Pole 4043978E) with a new composite sectional pole.

Project activities described above are anticipated to impact 0.017 acre of resources subject to Fish and Game Code Section 1602.


