**Project Title:** CSA 7a Storm Drain Washout Project (Notification of Lake Alteration, No. EPIMS-SLO-57601-R4)

**Project Location (San Luis Obispo):** The Project is located on the north shore of Lake Nacimiento, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California; Latitude 35.75199, Longitude -120.98511; Section 15, Township 20 South, Range 9 East; U.S. Geological Survey map Tierra Redonda Mountain; Assessor's Parcel Number 012-201-043.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake Alteration Agreement Notification No. EPIMS- SLO-57601-R4, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code, to San Luis Obispo County, represented by John Waddell.

The Project is limited to replacing a rocked impact basin, on the north shore of Lake Nacimiento, associated with the repair and replacement of an existing stormwater conveyance system at the wastewater treatment plant which serves Community Services District 7a.


