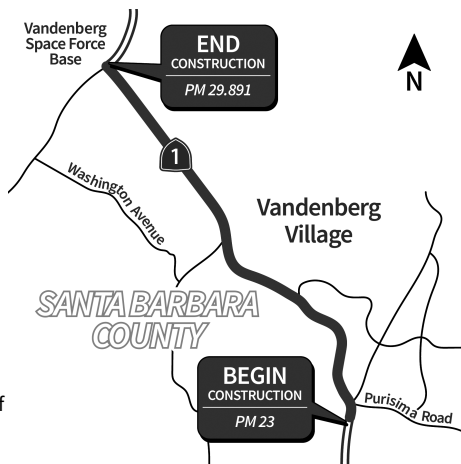

#### WHAT'S BEING PLANNED?

This project is on State Route 1 in Santa Barbara County starting at 0.3 miles south of Purisima Road and ending at the Vandenberg Space Force Base main gate and State Route 1 intersection. This project proposes to preserve 6 miles of Class 2 pavement between postmiles 23.0 and 29.9, rehabilitate 3 drainages, replace four signposts and panels, upgrade approximately 1,900 feet of guardrail to current safety standards, update 21 curb ramps to American Disability Act Standards, and install bicycle conflict markings at 8 locations. Shoulder widening is proposed at 3 locations.

#### WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?

Caltrans has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show the project will not significantly affect the quality of the environment. The report that explains why is called an Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration. This notice is to inform you of the preparation of the Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration and of its availability for you to read and comment on. A public meeting with an in-person and virtual component will be held to give you an opportunity to talk about certain design features of the project with Caltrans' staff before the final design is selected.
